Upcoming Meetings and Site Plan Approval

June 15 - Design Review Committee (DRC) – the goal of this meeting is to seek approval for a letter to submit to the City Clerk's office, which will trigger the Site Plan Approval process.

June 16 - Due to a scheduling conflict, the City proposed cancelling the Community meeting on June 16. It was agreed that the community would be invited to the DRC meeting scheduled the night prior, on June 15. NV5 will send out an email blast notifying community members of the meeting adjustment.

July 21 - The next community meeting is scheduled for July 21.

Recently Filed Suit

The City noted that several members of the community have filed suit claiming that the NewCAL project is violating Article 97 protection of open space and challenging the decision of the Newton Historic Commission with regards to the landmark application. It was noted that the NewCAL schedule will remain unchanged as the project will continue to work towards Site Plan Approval with the Design Review Committee and City Council over the next few months, which will be followed by the completion of the design development and construction document design phases.

Interior Update

Dan Chen presented six (6) interior 3-D renderings, based on feedback at the last Working Group meeting on May 24. The images simulated the entrance experience from vantage points of the main entry vestibule, double height space as well as from the rear entry and reception. Primary updates included the following:

- Creation of a seating area in the vestibule as well as in the main lobby
- Door added at lounge, creating a separation from the lobby
- Library rendering (new)
- Furniture layouts and placements in 2nd floor rooms

The following highlights were noted:

Vestibule and Lobby

- A built-in seating was created along the right-side wall in the main entry vestibule.
- A built-in seating was created at the main lobby, at a box shaped area carved out from beneath the main stair
- Double doors at lobby would create a closed off lounge area
- The existing chandelier (salvaged item) was shown in the double height lobby.
- Interior and exterior horizontality needs to be coordinated.

- Historic mitigation plan may want to be considered/incorporated when selecting/locating artwork.
- Concern was expressed about vestibule automatic door button being too far from the doors.
- Concern was expressed about potential of someone hitting their head at the built-in stair seating.
- It was noted that a single door to the library feels small. Double doors may be better suited.
- The light fixture above the reception desk may be another opportunity for historic mitigation.
- Library furnishings consideration needs to be given to visitor mobility. Merits and appropriateness of individual seating, rather than couches, was discussed to encourage independent and quiet work.

Design Review Committee Presentation

The following content will be presented for review with the DRC on June 15: Stormwater calculations and drainage, civil engineering, test pits which were performed two weeks ago, landscaping/trees and site furnishings, energy usage and embodied carbons feedback, floor plans, exterior elevations, and materials.

Additional Business

- Working Group meetings will be longer in the next phase of Design Development as more details of the design will be studied.
- The City is working through evaluating logistics of options for possible swing space during construction.
- Norm Meltz has resigned from the NewCAL Working Group.
