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Online Zoom meeting opened at 9:30AM.

The purpose of this meeting was for BH+A to share the design of the furniture for the three floors and the design of the façades.

- 1. First Floor
  - a. <u>Library</u> the furniture presented was: 3 square tables with 8 seats in the center area among 2 loveseats with a coffee table in the center, 3 computer stations on the southern wall, perimeter sitting on the north and east wall, the bookshelves will be located on the west wall.
    - The proposed bench shall be replaced by (2) armchairs.
    - Focused lightning shall be considered to make reading easier for users.
    - Electrical outlets shall be considered for the optimal function of the space.
  - b. <u>Reception</u> Design is in development.
  - c. Lounge Area
    - Trash receptacles shall be considered.
    - Juice bar and island are 34" tall, ADA accessible.
    - Magazine racks shall be considered.
  - d. <u>Restrooms</u>
    - A small table will be added in each restroom to place belongings.
    - (2) sets of (2) chairs and a table to be added outside the restroom area (in the corridor)
  - e. <u>Activity Room</u> Monitors/screens will be considered for people in the back of the room to be able to see the speaker in the front.
  - f. <u>Kiosk</u> To be re-located from the central hallway to be across the reception.

#### 2. Second Floor

- a. <u>Ceramics</u> Furniture/equipment is being developed.
- b. <u>Activity Room #3</u> Although the furniture is presented in a classroom layout, there is flexibility to be rearranged depending on programming needs. BH+A shall further study increasing the size of the storage room.
- c. <u>Senior Services</u> The entry closest to the Shine room shall be shifted northward so that the staff restroom is accessed from within the Senior Services program area.
- d. <u>General</u> A coat racks/hooks will be needed in each room. Lower and higher hooks will be included on the backs of bathroom doors.

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### 3. Third Floor

- a. <u>Game Room</u> BH+A presented the furniture layout: (2) pool tables, (1) ping pong table, multiple sets of (2) chairs/table along the perimeter. Per feedback at the last community update meeting a juice bar was added in the southern right corner of the room.
  - TV monitor shall be considered; location to be determined.
  - Multiple sets of (2) seater arrangements along the north and west walls shall be replaced by individual chairs with smaller tables along the north wall only.
  - Pool tables shall be rotated and shifted slightly to the west to create more space to accommodate square tables with (4) chairs/each.
  - Ping pong table shall be stored in the storage room.
  - Revised layout will be presented at the next Working Group meeting.
  - Juice bar in the game room shall be removed for circulation and cleaning purposes.
- b. <u>3-D Interior Perspectives</u> Rendered images were presented showing refinements since last week with regard to the lobby view at entry, lobby communicating stair, lobby view towards multipurpose room, gymnasium and walking track.
- c. <u>Exterior Elevations</u> BH+A presented (4) design alternatives for the North, South and West elevations, proposing different brick patterns and materials.
  - There was consensus to extend the white horizontal banding across elevations to emphasize the building horizontality. It was noted the added brick pattern above the horizontal banding generates a more dynamic façade.
